

How do I revise for different subjects?



Maths

- **MyMaths** – choose topics that you know you are weaker at.
- Using **Past Papers** for Edexcel spec – work your way through the exam paper
 - **Revision and Activity book** – use these when stuck on a past paper question
- **PiXL Maths App** – use when only got 5-10mins for quick revision

Geography

- **Doddle** HW – complete set HW quizzes prior to revision sessions
- **Black AQA revision book** – read 1 page of content then cover and try to recall. Use prior to 360° Book work to prepare.
- **Knowledge organisers** - reading content then covering and trying to recall
- **Topic 360° Books** – complete questions. Try to not use knowledge organisers or revision guides during this.

Philosophy and Ethics

- Watch the revision videos on **YouTube World Faiths channel**
 - **BBC Bitesize GCSE Hinduism and Christianity** section
 - **Twitter revision** with Mrs Bouttell #Twivision
- See **revision poster** for more ideas

Modern Foreign Languages

- Use **Quizlet, Memrise** or **Duolingo**
- **Re-write out paragraphs or sentences**, until you can do so just from memory
- Follow the **MFL Revision Timetable** provided
 - Use the **Revision guide** and the **Translation and Vocab books** provided

English Literature and Language

- Choose a set text you feel you know least and **re-read it**;
- Choose a character or theme from your set texts and watch some **videos and summaries** them from **Youtube**;
- Research and create **fact-files** of context for '**J&H**' and the **poetry anthology**;
- Complete a **past paper** and write under the timed conditions to practise as realistically as possible. Use the **revision guide** for support.
- Look-up quizzes and worksheets on spelling, punctuation and grammar on **Doddle** - study and then complete them

Science

- **Doddle** – revision set by teacher
- Use the emailed **GCSE videos** sent
 - Teacher issued **past papers**
 - Use the **revision guides** provided
 - **BBC Bitesize – KS4 Science**

History

- Use your **folder/exercise book** for you're the knowledge and content needed.
 - Revise using your **Edexcel Revision Guides**. Remember, you will be examined on all four units: Crime & Punishment, Anglo-Saxons and Normans, British America and Weimar and Nazi Germany.
 - For each topic create a **mind-map or list of key points** and then attempt the suggested **exam style question from the guide**. You will also be able to access **sample exam papers** for each unit which are on **Doddle**.

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Music

- Focus on **Sound Pro** – log in (phone or computer) use the lessons and tests and any additional tasks set by your teacher under “My School”.
- **Google classroom** – Log in and review the resources e.g. Practise listening papers. Try to check your alerts regularly as tasks will be set by your teacher.
- **Revision Guide – WJEC/Eduqas GCSE Music Revision Guide** - Use in conjunction with your own class notes in your folder.

Health and Social Care

Knowledge Organisers - pick a topic. Read for 3 minutes then get someone to test you. Repeat

Pearson Revision guide - read a page, attempt the 'now try this' question, then check against the answers at the back of the book

Lifestyle data booklet - practice reading BMI charts, peak flow charts, blood pressure charts and pulse rate data. Complete the practice questions and check against the answers at back of the booklet. Make **Flash cards** for key groups of information - factors affecting health, health and lifestyle indicators, care values. Get someone to test you on them

Engineering

- Complete the **Doddle set exam questions**.
- Key areas to revise...
- Commercial Production Processes Market Forces** (Push – Pull)
- **Complete NEA** (75% of final grade)

Drama

Read through the text *The Crucible*.
Use/Study the ‘Complete Revision Guide’ and answer the questions on: A Comedy About a Bank Robbery and *The Crucible*.

Business Studies

- Firstly use **PURPLE ‘Revision Workbook’** to practice exam style questions. Then check your answers using help at the back and the ‘Revision Guide’ textbook.
- Past papers from new **EDEXCEL Specification (GCSE Business)**. For knowledge only revision use past multiple choice papers (old paper 1 exams).
- Practice the **P.L.U.C approach to explain Q’s**

Btec Physical Education

- Learn **definitions**: You will be asked them
- Complete **exam Qs in revision guide**
- Practice the **equations**: You will have to work out training zones.
- Have **sporting examples** prepared for each section. You will have to apply knowledge to practical examples.

Textiles

- **Pinterest** - use Pinterest and relevant online sources for gathering images to guide exam preparation
- Resources - Carefully **plan preparation schedule** around when resources are available both in school and at home
- **Fabrics** - sourcing fabrics in advance will give you the best opportunity to plan for your exam in advance and feel fully prepared.

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Resistant Materials

- Use technologystudent.com, click on the 'New D&T GCSE' link and revise the topics listed. Ideally spend 15 minutes each evening and click on 2 different links and make notes on the information.
- 15% of the exam is based on **Maths skills**. In order to prepare for summer exam please revise the following:
The use of π to calculate the area of a circle and the circumference of a circle.
Working out the surface area of squares, rectangles and triangles.
Mechanical advantage and velocity ratio equations.
- Use the 'Core' section 1 and 'Timbers' section 7 of the **Edexcel GCSE (9-1) Design and Technology text book**

Computing Science

- Use the Quizzes and materials on **Doddle**.
- Use the materials on <https://www.senecalearning.com/>
- Use the **Zig-Zag Revision guide**.

Graphics

- Revise the **key components of graphic design** using your **blue book**.
- Analyse the **design briefs** set on **Doddle**.
- **Review pieces of graphic design** using the key components of graphic design, ensuring that you link each key component together.

Food Preparation and Nutrition

- Use the **revision cards** that you made throughout Year 10.
- Refer to the **6 knowledge sheets** you were given prior to mocks and complete the **mini questions** to start you off.
- Look at '**Fun Kitchen**' **videos** on Youtube and make notes on the function & chemical properties of food and cooking technics.
