

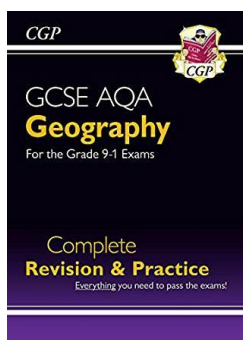
GCSE Geography Revision 2019 – What is on offer?

You have got your copy of **CGP 'Complete Revision and Practice'** revision guide. It contains some excellent revision materials designed for all ability ranges along with practice questions.

Doddle has a series of short tasks such as quizzes to attempt. These are short and interactive. The school website has a 'Geography Revision' section. There you can find a range of revision booklets aimed at students who are aspiring to gain a Grade 5 or higher. These booklets are specific to the **GCSE Geography AQA specification** and the units and case studies we have chosen to study. You could use them at home or your weekly study period. You could also use the PiXL app on your device and complete some small interactive tasks on the go!



Once you get your mock paper back go through it question by question and act on any feedback your teacher has given you using a green pen. You watch the teacher led '**Mock Talk Through**' clip found in the revision section of the school website to help you. This will help you break down the questions, practice exam technique and revise the content all at the same time.

A good idea to maintain interest is to vary revision techniques such as using *mind maps, revision cards, past exam papers plus using online revision websites.*
